



College Readiness Program

The College Readiness Program consists of three components:

- **Summer Residential Camp** - College Readiness Participants will stay overnight in the UNM dorms and experience the academic and social life the university offers. The summer session consists of leadership activities, team building exercises, tours and presentations from UNM programs and colleges. **Summer Program will take place June 20-21, 2018.**
- **ACT Prep & College and Career Readiness (Fall 2018 & Spring 2019 Semesters of Junior Year)** - Participants will complete a Mock ACT and will be given individualized and detailed scores to use as they work through ACT prep curriculum throughout the two semesters. Students will also participate in college & career readiness curriculum designed to help students prepare for the college application process, choosing a major & career and developing career readiness skills. Accepted applicants will be given class dates during the parent/student orientation.

Participants will work with Educational Mentor Tutors and UNM staff that will provide support and guidance as participants prepare for college.

Eligibility

- Current sophomore who will be a junior in the 2018-2019 school year
- Live in the Albuquerque metro and surrounding areas
- Low-income
- Or First-Generation
- Have a minimum of a 2.5 Cumulative GPA

We understand room and board will be provided at an on-campus dormitory and educational mentor/tutors will serve as chaperones 24-hours per day in the campus dormitories and at all daily activities. Our son/daughter will be required to comply with UNM and CPP-College Readiness rules and regulations, as well as all Federal, State and Local laws and regulations. We have received and read the program rules and responsibilities.

We understand that our child will participate in off-campus activities. We further understand that UNM and the CPP-College Readiness Program will supervise all off-campus, planned activities of our child. The University of New Mexico CPP-College Readiness Program will not be responsible for any accidents, injuries or other misfortune which may occur as a result of a participant’s violation of these rules, regulations or policies.

If the student decides to leave the program voluntarily before the advertised end date, the CPP-College Readiness Program will release the student only into the custody of the parent/legal guardian and will not be responsible for the student after he/she leaves the UNM campus. The CPP-College Readiness Program reserves the right to disenroll a student at any time due to a violation of any rule, regulation or policy established by UNM and/or the CPP-College Readiness Program.

We understand and acknowledge that certain risks are inherent to participating in recreational activities due to one’s own actions, the actions of other participants or a combination of both. These risks may result in injury, minor or serious, as well as damage to personal property.
