MISSION

To motivate young students throughout the State of New Mexico to cultivate career goals and to prepare them for college life.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Participants get a taste of college life and develop complex skills in research, conducting a trial, critical thinking, team building, leadership and techniques of persuasion and debate during this week long residential program. At the end of the camp, participants put their new skills into action with a mock trial. Students also witness New Mexico's legal system in action by meeting with judges and practicing attorneys and touring various relevant sites in Albuquerque. Students reside in the UNM Residence Halls and are supervised by the College Prep Program staff.
